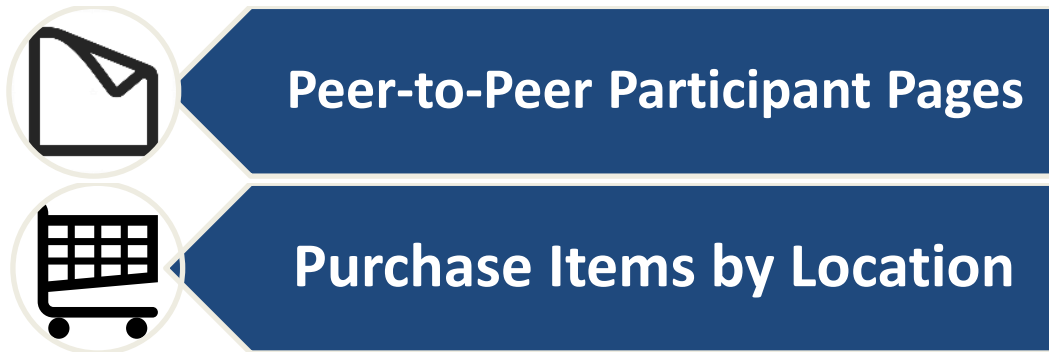


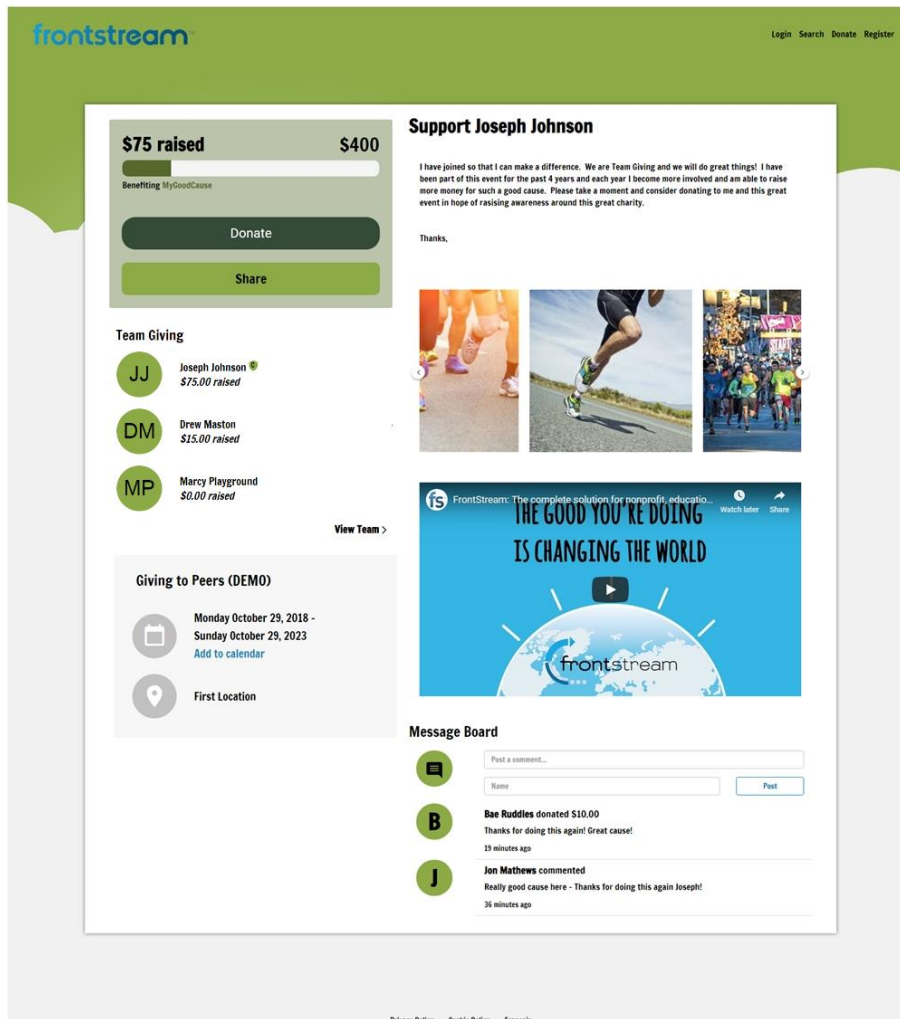
As part of our commitment to continuously update and enhance our Fundraising system, we recently made the following enhancements to the Artez Platform.



Peer to Peer Template Participant Pages

This is a BETA release. Users may experience issues when using the editor or viewing the live pages. Additional functionality will be added in future sprints.

We have added Participant Pages to the Peer-to-Peer template. Admin users now can edit the default participant page look and feel in the Panorama Event Builder. Participants will now get the new, updated functionality as well as a new look and feel for their pages. Participants still can add a personalized message, pictures and a video. All live pages are Mobile Responsive.



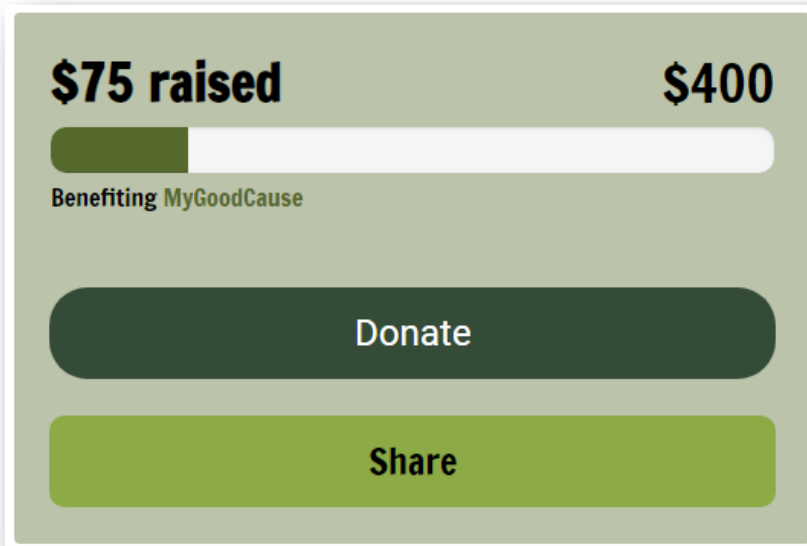
Fundraising Section

The Fundraising Section displays:

- Progress Bar with Amount Raised and Participant Goal
- Donate button
 - Donate button directs the user to the donation form with the Participant pre-selected as the solicitor.
- Social Share button
 - Share button displays options for sharing the current Participant Page. Facebook, Twitter and Email sharing options.



This section is sticky and will stay in view when the user scrolled down the page.







Team Section

The Team Section only appears if the participant is a team member or team captain. The section will list:

- Team Name
- Team Members
- Amount the Team Member has raised
- Link to the Team Page (Team Pages Not Developed Yet)

The Team Captain will be marked with a “C” Icon. This Icon color can be independently changed in the Panorama Event Builder in Theme.

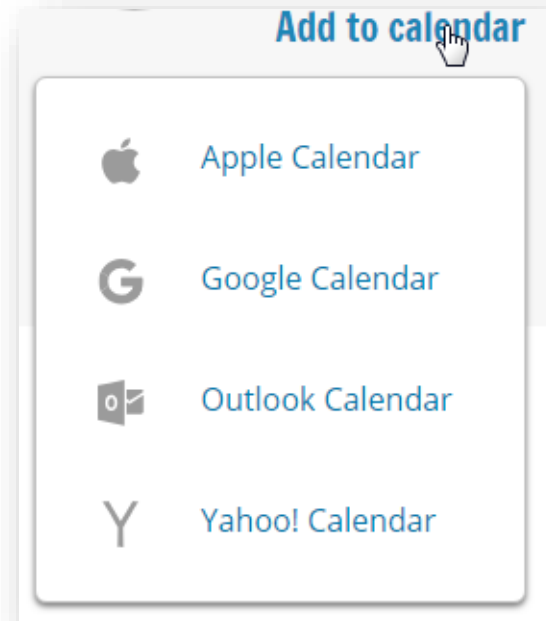
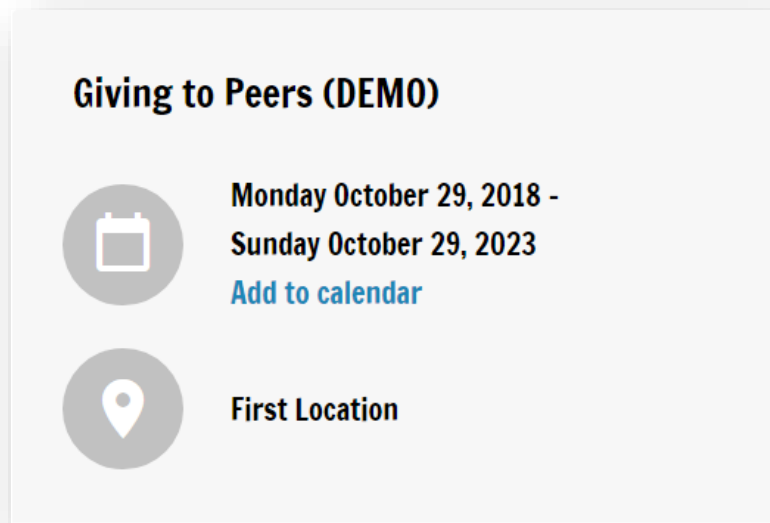

Event Details Section

The Event Details Section displays information about the event and location the participant has registered for. It displays:

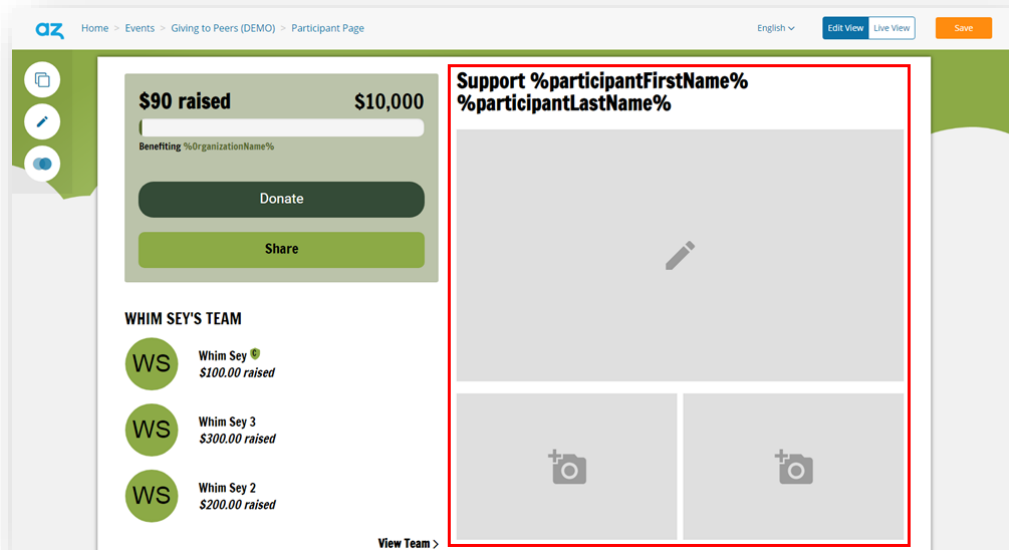
- Event Name
- Event/Location Start and End Date
- Add to Calendar Option (Apple, Google, Outlook, Yahoo)
- Location Name registered for



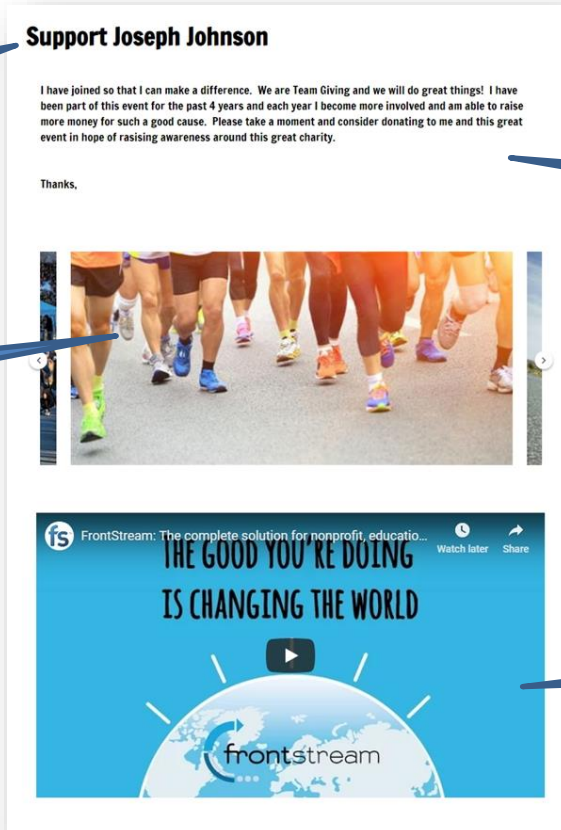
Participant Story Section

The Participant Story Section is where the participant can Customize their page adding Text, Images and a Video. A default setup can also be created in the Panorama Event Builder by the Admin which will show up on all Participant Pages before the participant makes any edits to their page.

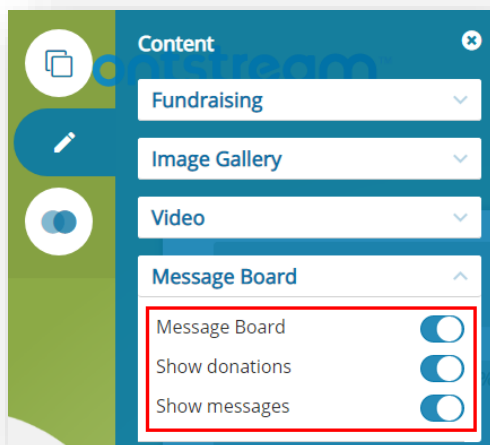

Message Board

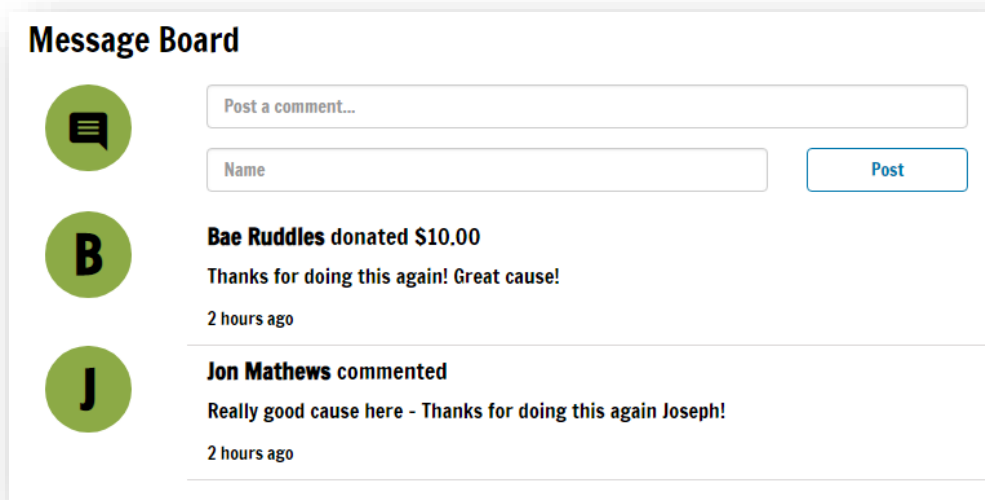
The Message Board can be enabled/disabled, and settings changed in the Panorama Event Builder. Setting Options are:

- Message Board Enabled or Disabled
- Show Donations made to the Participant on the Message Board Enabled or Disabled
- Show Messages on the Message Board Enabled or Disabled

Note: You Must have either Messages or Donations Enabled if the Message Board is Enabled. You cannot have the Message Board Enabled and both Messages and Donations Disabled.



The Message Board will appear on the Participant Page and users will have the option to leave messages on the Participant Page directly or during a donation to the participant.



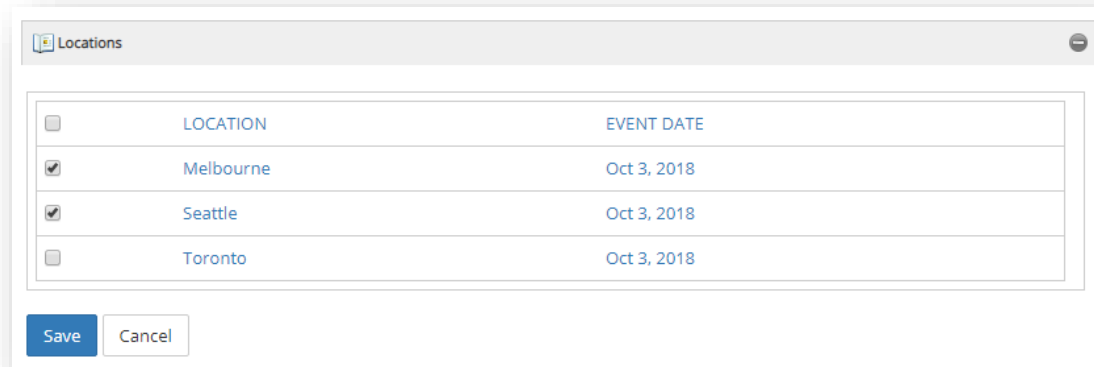
Things to Note:

- Page Message, Images and Video added in the Fundraising Hub will appear on the new Participant Pages.
 - Only one Video will display per participant page (Future Sprints will build out a new Fundraising Hub Experience).
- Profile Picture functionality will be added in a future sprint.
- Participant Goal must be enabled in Event Settings for the Progress Bar to appear in the Fundraising Section.
- You Must have either Messages or Donations Enabled if the Message Board is Enabled. You cannot have the Message Board Enabled and both Messages and Donations Disabled.

Purchase Items by Location

You can now select a location while setting up Purchase Items for your Event. Purchase Items will now only appear if the location chosen in registration includes that Purchase Item. This will give the ability for organizations to sell different Purchase Items for different Locations. This works for Big Browser and Mobile Registration.

- When setting up a Purchase Item you will now see a Location selection option.
- Select the Location you want the Purchase Item to appear on and Save



Now this Purchase Item will only appear if the registrant selected a location assigned to it.

This Purchase Item will also appear in the Fundraising Hub under the “Merchandise” option only if the registrant is registered for a Location assigned to the Purchase Item.

Important Information:

- Existing Purchase Items are automatically updated with ALL Locations Enabled.
- New Locations added to an event are not automatically Enabled on Existing Purchase Items.
- Newly created Purchase Items are automatically assigned to ALL locations but can be changed during initial setup.

Bug & Minor Enhancements:

- Resolved an issue where Facebook Single Sign-on was not signing in users.
- Resolved an Issue where the link to Panorama on the Admin Console login page was not working
- Added Sub UDFs to Proxy Registrants on Mobile Registration
