Dartmouth Walk to Make Cystic Fibrosis History Early Registration Contest Rules

PRIZE: The lucky winner will receive a one night stay at Hampton Inn & Suites in Dartmouth Crossing

The Prizes are not transferable or convertible to cash and must be accepted as awarded.

CONTEST PERIOD: The Contest begins at 12:00:01 a.m. Atlantic Time (AST) on May 1, 2019 and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. (AST) on May 15, 2019.

HOW TO ENTER: No purchase is required. To enter, you must already be registered for the Walk to Make Cystic Fibrosis History – Dartmouth location, in support of the Cystic Fibrosis Canada, online at www.cysticfibrosis.ca/walk and have raised \$150, online verified between May 1 and May 15. This is in addition to any funds raised prior to May 1. <u>Or</u> write a minimum 500-word essay on why you want to help find a cure for cystic fibrosis and mail to: 109 Ilsley Avenue, Unit 1, Dartmouth Nova Scotia, B3B 1S8. If submitting an essay you must include your name, address and phone number on top of your essay, and include your signature at the bottom of your essay. All essays must be originals and not mechanically reproduced. If mailing in an essay entry, to be eligible for the contest, such entry must be received prior to 11:59 p.m. (AST) on the Contest Closing date.

Entrants who are under the age of majority in their province or territory of residence must have their essays signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Participants who fundraise online will automatically be entered into the prize draw, after registering online, through the official Web site (<u>www.cysticfibrosis.ca/walk</u>), provided online pledges are received prior to 11:59 pm (AST) on the Contest Closing Date.



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Maximum one entry per person – if it is discovered in the ordinary course of the contest that you entered more than once, you will be disqualified. All essays become the property of the sponsor, and will not be returned.

Please note only Dartmouth walk entrants are eligible for this contest

THE DRAW

A random draw from all eligible entries received (both pledge entries and essay entries) will be conducted by a Cystic Fibrosis Staff member, at its office in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia on Thursday, May 16th at 12:00 p.m. Atlantic Standard time, to award the Prize, subject to these contest rules. You do not need to be present at the draw in order to win. The Prize will be awarded to the person(s) named in the first entry drawn, subject to these contest rules, if he/she (i) correctly answers, without human, mechanical, electronic or other assistance, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by Sponsor during a pre-arranged, mutually convenient telephone call (if selected entrant is under the age of 13, such question may, at Sponsor's sole option, be answered by a parent or legal guardian, without human, mechanical, electronic or other assistance, rules.

The chance of being selected will depend on the number of eligible entries received.

The entrant whose entry is drawn will be contacted by phone or email.
