

## Team Captain Roles and Responsibilities

- 1. Recruit 15 pullers who are each committed to raise money for Special Olympics Florida. Give your team members time to fundraise. Recruit, and register pullers by September 1!
- 2. Set a team fundraising goal and ask each puller to raise a specific amount of money to help achieve the team fundraising goal.

*Example*: A team of 15 pullers can easily raise \$1,500 if each puller raises \$100.

- 3. Challenge yourself or at least one puller on your team to raise \$1,000. (Have you checked out the fundraising prizes?!)
- 4. Help all your team members register on the Plane Pull online fundraising webpage by sending them an email from your Plane Pull webpage that includes a link for them to register on your team.
- 5. Help each puller achieve their personal fundraising goal. Encourage use of the online fundraising tool as a quick and easy way to ask for secure donations via email.
- 6. If applicable, obtain a matching gift forms from your company and distribute to your pullers.
- 7. Motivate and encourage your pullers from start to finish.
  - a. Identify any individuals on your team who are connected to the mission of Special Olympics Florida and ask them to share their inspiring story with other pullers.
  - b. Recognize pullers for progressing towards and achieving their goals.
